Certification Description:

Certification is required for compliance with erosion and sediment control provisions on MN/DOT and State Aid funded projects and to provide comprehensive training of inspectors, project managers, contractors, and designers. Certified MN/DOT, local highway agency, and contractor personnel are required for projects involving bridges crossing rivers and streams, major grading projects, design/build projects, and all projects requiring an NPDES permit. Certification is valid for 3 years.

Certification Vs. No Certification:

For those who wish to be certified by the University of Minnesota Erosion and Sediment Control Program, the “extra step” will be to complete an open book exam at the end of the day. All of the information needed for the exam is presented in the class materials.
