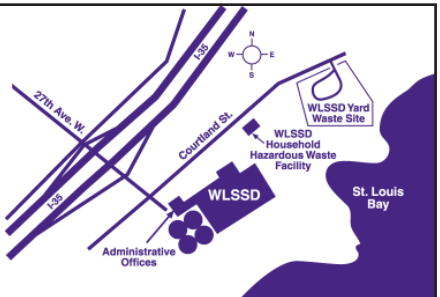
Do you have expired or unwanted medications in your home?

Follow these 3 easy steps:

1. Leave medication in original container
(you may scratch out personal information if desired but leave the medication information intact)
2. Keep out of reach of children before event
3. Bring to one of WLSSD's drive-thru events

If medications are flushed, they may not be removed from wastewater and could end up in the St. Louis River and Lake Superior. Help protect the water from contamination by medication; ***it's a no drainer!***

Can't make it to a collection event?

Follow the 5 steps below to dispose of medicines in the garbage. Medicine can only be accepted by WLSSD during special collection events.

Instructions for Disposal in the Garbage



Scratch out the patient's name



Add liquid, sawdust or spices to destroy the product



Seal container with strong tape



Hide it in a non-transparent container or bag



Throw it away as close to trash pick-up as possible
