



Goals for 2009

Plant 1,000 white spruce and white pine along the Flute Reed River.

Continue to fulfill the terms of our Surface Water Assessment Grant.

Sponsor a workshop in Hovland, with the U of Minn Extension Service, on how climate change will effect the forests in Cook County.

Continue to grow our membership – goal of 40 paid members by year end.

Seek a grant to help us determine flow rates, monitor water quality at multiple sites up the river and conduct GPS work to map all tributaries.

Help Cook County Soil & Water with a watershed driveway assessment if they get their Coastal Program grant.

Get the erosion damage repaired and improve the site at the new bridge on North Road.

Improve the situation up Camp 20 Road where vehicles regularly drive across the river's streambed.

Report findings from our water monitoring last year – turbidity levels, nitrate and phosphate loads, temperature data, etc.
