Description: Implement storage practices to reduce storm water issues with short-term storage of particulate materials (soil, peat, sand, and gravel).

Measurable Goals:	Timeline
1. Review current practices for storage of landscape particulate materials	• October 2004
2. Develop guidelines for storage of landscape particulate materials	• December 2004
3. Implement guidelines	• May 2005
4. Provide the training for those who handle these materials	• May 2005
5. Review annually for effectiveness and update if necessary	• Annually

Specific Components:

- Guidelines for storage of landscape particulate such as; amounts, whether they must be covered, time line need, and sites suitable for storage, short term vs. long term.
- Implement guidelines.

Educational Components:

- Provide training regarding handling and storage of particulate materials.
