Title: **Snow Storage**

Addresses Minimum Measure: I Education
III Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination
VI Pollution Prevention/Good Housekeeping

Target Audience: University Employees
Maintenance Contractors

Description: Identify snow storage areas and their effects on the surrounding area.
Map snow storage areas. Identify priorities regarding snow storage and spring clean up.

Measurable Goals:

1. Identify and map major snow storage areas
2. Review the storage areas, prioritize and make recommendations
3. Develop procedures
4. Implement and train

Timeline:

- March 2005
- April 2005
- August 2005
- October 2005

Specific Components:

- Map snow storage areas. Distinguish between plowed snow storage and hauled snow storage.
- Identify issues in the areas snow is stored and make recommendations to treat the snow melt.
- Document recommendation decisions.
- Procedures for storing snow to be established and implemented
- Implement changes as needed.

Educational Components:

- Train snow control operators where to pile snow and why they should not pile it in certain areas.
