Title: **Salt/ Sand Storage Facility**

Addresses Minimum Measures: I Public Education and Outreach
III Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination
VI Pollution Prevention/Good Housekeeping

Description: Provide good housekeeping practices for the new salt/ sand storage facility and the handling of salt and sand during mixing, loading, and storage.

Measurable Goals:

1. Review current practices that relate to facility
2. Develop procedures
3. Implement procedures
4. Review procedures, inspect for effectiveness, and update as necessary

Timeline:

- May 2003
- Aug 2003
- Sept 2003
- Annual

Specific Components:

- Review current practices with staff and how they will incorporate with the new storage facility.
- Write good housekeeping procedures for storage, mixing, loading, and clean up.
- Review procedures and compound annually to evaluate how effective the procedures are.

Educational Components:

- Create procedural manual (brochure) and post in facility.
- Have meetings with staff to explain requirements.
