Title: **Fueling System Spill Protection**

Addresses Minimum Measures: I Public Education and Outreach
III Illicit Discharge Detection and Elimination
IV Pollution Prevention/Good Housekeeping

Target Audience: University Employees

Description: Review and update current procedures for fueling vehicles and filling gas cans, and identify equipment necessary in the event of a spill.

Measurable Goals:

1. Review fueling procedures and spill protection materials available for the fueling area
2. Update procedures and implement changes
3. Develop training program for proper fueling and spill protection procedures in the fueling area
4. Provide training for those with fuel keys
5. Identify and provide necessary spill containment equipment

Timeline:

- September 2003
- October 2003
- April 2004
- June 2004
- July 2004

Specific Components:

- Review procedures and spill protection materials.
- Provide protection to storm water sewer drains by providing spill retention equipment.
- Provide a copy of Spill Prevention Control and Counter Measures Plan for the R.W. Bridges Fleet Grounds Maintenance Facility.

Educational Components:

- Train employees how to react in the event of a spill.
- Train employees regarding proper handling during fuel transfer (pump to vehicle) and (pump to can).
