During this half-day workshop, you'll receive practical advice on how to make better proactive, cost-effective choices in winter parking lot and sidewalk management.

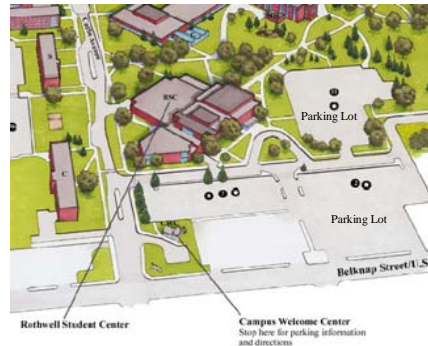
Topics covered include:

Directions

From Duluth, MN: Take Highway 2 across the Bong Bridge into Superior. Follow Highway 2/Belknap St. through Superior. At the stoplight for Catlin Ave., turn right and enter campus. Rothwell Student Center will be the first large building on your right. Park in either lot 2 or 11.

From Wisconsin: If you're driving from the south, take US Highway 53. If coming from the east, use Highway 2. Both highways junction east of Superior. Follow them into the city until you reach the traffic signal for Belknap St., where Highway 2 turns left. Follow Highway 2/Belknap St. for approximately three-quarter miles and you will see UW-Superior on your left. Turn left at the stoplight onto Catlin Ave. and enter campus. Rothwell Student Center will be the first large building on your right. Park in either lot 2 or 11.
